Report on Activity:

- Department of Zoology in collaboration with IQAC of A.G. & S.G.S Degree College of Arts & Science celebrated "World Sparrow Day" on 20th March 2023.
- The theme of the program is "Sparrow Conservation: Today's Need".
- The Principal and Special officer of the college graced the function.
- Sparrows in cages are exhibited to students, teaching and non-teaching staff. Posters of Old World and New world sparrows are prepared and exhibited by students.
- Smt.D. A. Kiranmayee HoD of Zoology explained about the behavioural aspects of sparrows and why sparrows are not visible nowadays. The most common reasons for decline of the species are loss of habitat and loss of sources of food and water. One of the measures to be followed in cities is nest building and provision of food and water in small utensils or bottles.
- Nests of sparrows are displayed and students have been inspired and motivated about nest building, thereby preserving the sparrow species. Special Officer of the College K. Satyanarayana appreciated the event and said that, such activities help to create awareness in students for conserving Nature and Wild Life. Principal Dr. V. Sree Ram also motivated the students to locate sparrows in college campus and provide them with nests and feed.
